



Learning by doing to train the professionals of tomorrow: welcome to TTS.

The Work Efficiency Institute is proposing professional training in technical fields in which around 5000 students are training each year. Focused on practical training, TTS is divided into 4 campuses in Vantaa, Nurmijärvi and Turku.

Founded in 1924, TTS offers 14 fields of study, including Forest and Garden, Construction and Transport Services.

To help companies and industries, TTS is engaging in research and development to provide sustainable solutions. Their services are delivered through publicly funded projects, corporate initiatives, and training programs.

Each year, more than 1,500 students graduate with either a full or partial qualification. Of those who complete a full qualification, 87% find employment or continue their studies. Among those with a partial qualification, the figure is 60%. In addition, the school is proposing a range of short-term training courses, with new students participating every week.

Hands-on learning at TTS

At TTS, each student spends almost half of their training on the field. A part of the formation takes place in a company, which is an opportunity for the students who want to be employed after. Technical workshops, company projects and professional simulations are an integral part of the program.

The short-term training allows students to acquire know-how quickly, while obtaining a diploma at the end of their learning. Moreover, the integration possibilities are made throughout the year, which makes the school more flexible and adaptable.

With its training programs rooted in the reality of the field, TTS continues to attract those who want to learn differently.
