



Our erasmus experience at TTS' : What we learned and created

We are 3 french students, from France; we are studying communication, in a training center, in Aix-en-Provence.

We had the opportunity to participate in an Erasmus+ program, proposed by our school last year : this is how we came out in Helsinki, at TTS.

What we learned ?

As a personal experience, a lot of things were new for us : being alone in another country, and learning the habits and customs of this one.

By being employed at TTS, we discovered a lot of Finland : we've been to four campuses in the south of the country : Rajamäki, Turku, Vantaa and Nurmijärvi. We had the opportunity to see and participate in the training in these four places; and we learned a lot about it !

We improved our English skills by working every day with teachers, students and staff members from different countries. Communication was sometimes a challenge, but it pushed us to be more confident

This was an amazing experience, especially in the field of "communication" which is very varied for each of us.

By the way, we saw a lot of animals that we cannot see in France : mooses, and reindeer ! And of course, the moomins were a big part of our adventure, and they came to France with us.

What we created?

We were collecting media to promote the training on social media and the website. We interviewed professors and students, to understand the expectations and motivation of each.

We develop our strategy on social media, especially Instagram, Tiktok and Youtube. At the same time, we wrote 3 articles, available on the website.

Through interviews, photos and videos, we were able to highlight the values of TTS and the diversity of its training programs.

This Erasmus+ experience at TTS was unforgettable. It helped us grow both personally and professionally. We discovered Finland, its culture, its people and its educational system, while improving our skills in communication.
